This qualification provides an academic pathway entry into SIT50422 Diploma of Hospitality Management.



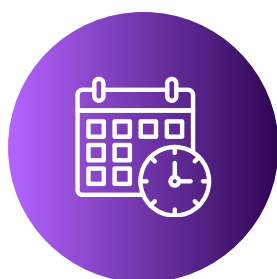
